

MANAGEMENT OF STUDIES

THE TUITION FEE at SSE Riga is 6000 EUR.

The tuition fee covers all study costs, including handouts, printouts and textbooks provided by the SSE Riga library as well WiFi internet access.

SWEDISH GOVERNMENT GRANTS

The Stockholm School of Economics in Riga (SSE Riga) invites applicants to compete for 20 Swedish Government Grants for financing studies in the three-year BSc. Programme in Economics and Business at SSE Riga.

Preference is given to applicants being residents of **BELARUS AND MOLDOVA**

Applicants from Georgia and Ukraine are also invited.

THE TOTAL GRANT AMOUNTS TO 30 000 EUR AND COVERS

- Three years of full tuition (6 000 EUR/year)**
- Free accommodation in the SSE Riga Student Residences**
- Monthly stipend of 200 EUR to cover living expenses.**

ACCOMMODATION

We offer newly renovated accommodation that is safe and secure; there are special study rooms and WiFi connections available in the building. This is available to SSE Riga students for EUR 80 - 100 a month, and is just 20 minutes from the School.

RESIDENCE PERMIT

Students from non-EU countries have to apply for a residence permit in the nearest Embassy or Consulate of Latvia. It is important to note that this is a time-consuming process and could take up to two months.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Eligibility

- Candidates who will have completed secondary school education by July 2011.
- Minimum grade in Mathematics and English: 8 on a scale of 10, or equivalent on a comparable scale.

One year of university experience will be considered as an advantage


15TH PLACE IN THE FINANCIAL TIMES RANKING OF TOP EUROPEAN BUSINESS SCHOOLS 2009*

THE PROGRAMME IS RUN ON A MODULAR BASIS

I.e. only 1-2 core courses are delivered at the same time. This allows students to concentrate on one subject at a time.

In parallel, students are encouraged to attend elective courses of their interest. The elective courses range from the humanities, including languages (French, German, Latvian for foreigners, Russian, Spanish, Swedish), philosophy, and argumentation skills, to social sciences, including economic history, globalization issues and development, audit and taxation in the Baltics, and social entrepreneurship.

STUDIES AT SSE RIGA REQUIRE IN-DEPTH INVOLVEMENT OF EVERY STUDENT



Attendance at lectures and seminars is often mandatory. In nearly every subject there are group assignments, reports, or project work.

Students who pass all core courses, a few elective courses, two internships and the bachelor thesis are awarded the bachelor of science (bsc) degree.

Having completed the programme, SSE Riga graduates possess excellent skills in analysis and critical thinking and rational argumentation skills, and are both entrepreneurial and professional. Graduates are recognised and sought-after in the labour market in the Baltics, Europe and worldwide.
